Biography

Dr. Michael A. Greenfield

Associate Deputy Administrator for Technical Programs - NASA HQ

Dr. Michael A. Greenfield is Associate Deputy Administrator for Technical Programs of NASA, responsible for assessing technical management, operational planning, and implementation activities of aeronautical and space programs. He began his career at the Air Force Materials Laboratory in Dayton, Ohio, and later joined NASA as an aerospace technology program manager in 1979. He moved to NASA's Office of Safety and Mission Assurance in 1986 where he became an Agency leader in the technical disciplines and management innovations needed for safe and successful programs and operations. During his 38 years in the aerospace technology field, Dr. Greenfield has expanded U.S. understanding and capabilities in materials and metallurgy, nondestructive evaluation, risk management, safety, reliability, and quality assurance. He holds a doctorate in metallurgy from New York University and master's degree in engineering management from the Catholic University of America.
